








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

i. Counseling / Mentoring

All faculty members are playing the role of "Faculty Counselor". One faculty counselor counsels 20 students, and he / she keeps track of the students' academics, attendance; sorts out problems; sends periodic reports to parents and apprises the Principal and the Head of the Department about the progress of the students. Students are free to approach the faculty counselor without inhibition about academics, administration, career and personal matters. The teacher monitors the same set of students year after year to realize overall progress at the end of the course.

ii. Career Counseling

Career Counseling is done with the help of counseling cell along with the support of department.

iii. Medical facilities

Campus is connected with LG Hospital which provides total health care and health protection with its infrastructure, experienced doctors and nurses, state of art equipment, patient care personnel who work round the clock to provide the highest standards of medical care.

xi. Alumni Activities


The institution has an Alumni Association which contributes for institutional, academic and infrastructure developments. Placements and Special lectures are arranged through the alumni.
